Youth Activities



Detached work taking place in both St Albans and Dacorum Districts in parks and open spaces, with experienced youth workers

to offer, socially distanced conversation which will lead to our service supporting the most vulnerable young people in need in 1:1 support or those who could make use of our online groups.

In July we will increase the number of sessions into the evenings as we are getting reports of gatherings and sometimes nuisance incidents.

National Citizens Service (NCS) Update: - personal development programme for years 11 and 12 (15-17 year olds) - currently awaiting approval of the new virtual/outdoor offer.

Positive Alternatives Positive Alternatives is a project for young people aged 11-17 incorporating practical sport or art sessions with interactive workshops which explore personal safety, understanding exploitation, gang culture and crime. Each session includes 2 hours of sports /

arts activities delivered by specialist staff. On completion of the programme young people will receive a certificate of participation and a £30 Amazon voucher.

Parks and Outdoor Activities

Following the Government announcement in June, most playgrounds across the borough reopened on Saturday 4 July 2020. Please note that some facilities, such as public toilets, may not be open at all sites.



There are four adventure playgrounds across the borough, which are free to use and cater for 8 to 16 year olds (children under 8 are welcome when accompanied by an adult). They are a safe environment

for children to meet, play and learn. In accordance with government guidance, the four adventure playgrounds in Dacorum will open from Monday 6 July at 4pm. Children must be supervised at all times by an appropriate adult, regardless of age. <u>More info</u>
