
We also received a very generous donation from the Hertfordshire Cake Company, who we would like to say a big thank you to!


#### Why I became an Ohana Champion:


"Wanting to help others is important to me. I thought that this would be a great opportunity to build relationships and gain experience in an area I am very interested in (family support)."
