## Key updates:

- 1. **Prescriptions** we will continue to maintain people on their scripts. Individual circumstances (i.e. self-isolation) will be addressed as needed we will adjust as required. If you're concerned about a client, please ask them to contact the service directly using our phone number: **0800 652 3169**
- 2. **Groups** we are <u>cancelling all groups</u> until the situation changes in order to keep our clients and staff healthy. We will continue to be responsible for the health of the people who use our service.
- 3. **Saturday services** starting on **March 21**<sup>st</sup>, we are suspending all Saturday services so we can prioritise key support during the week.

- Remain open in our Hatfield, Stevenage, Watford and Hertford hubs satellite
  services are also open for now, but this may have to change if staffing levels
