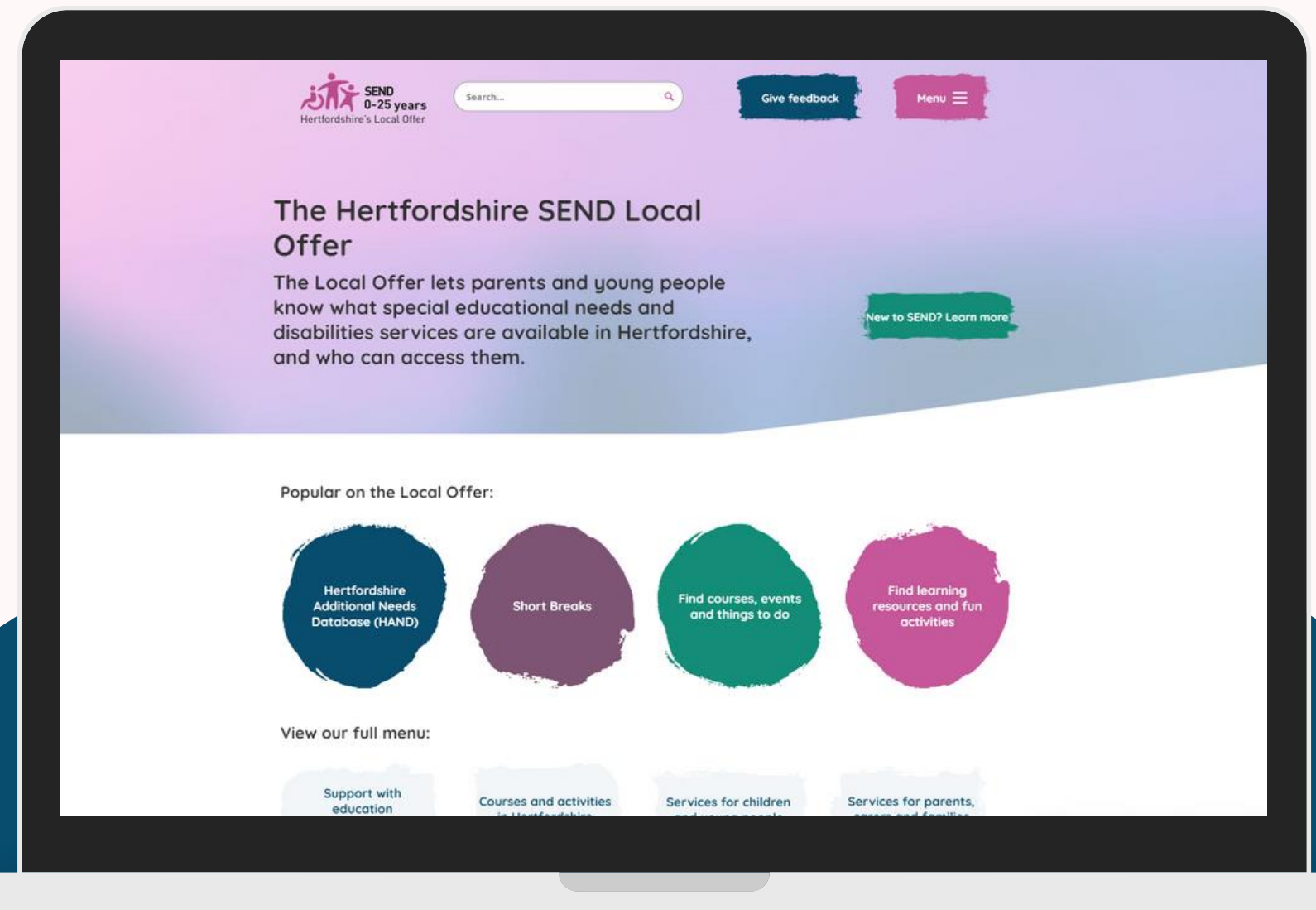

Services for children and young people (aged 0 - 25)

Speech, language and communication

Is our ability to make and understand sounds, receive and express messages and use and understand social rules.

Neurodiversity

Support for children and young people with ADHD and/or autism.

Mental health and wellbeing

Is about coping with daily challenges, knowing our potential and building relationships.

Specific learning difficulties

Learning difficulties such as dyslexia, dyscalculia and dyspraxia are different ways of comprehending or processing information.

Deafness and sight loss

Services for learners with varying levels of vision impairment and/or deafness

Physical needs

Are temporary or permanent needs that affect your physical capacity or mobility.

Behaviours that challenge

Are a range of behaviours that could put yourself or others at risk, these can be physical, verbal or non-verbal.

Education support

Is extra help with your child or young person's learning or development.

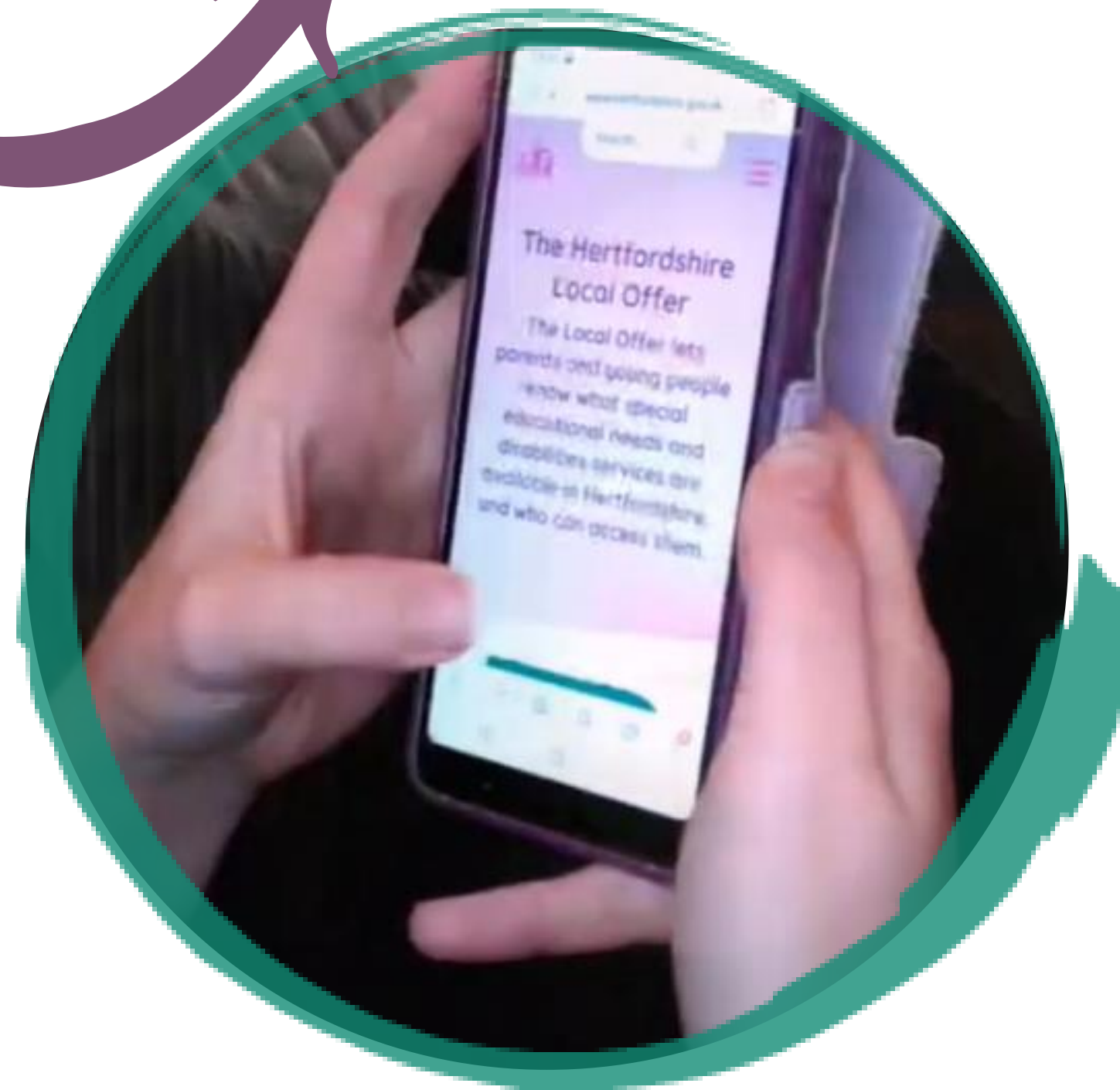
